Council-Funded Projects Receive Awards

Project Director Karen Loughmiller and Archivist Betsy Murray, both of the Asheville Public Library, received the Buncombe County's 2009 Excellence in Public Service Award in the "Improving Diversity" category for the Humanities Council-funded oral history/documentary photography project "**Twilight of a Neighborhood: Asheville's East End - c.1970**".

The Gaston County Museum of Art & History has won the Award of Merit from the American Association of State and Local History for the exhibit component of "**Standing on a Box: Lewis Hine's National Child Labor Committee Photography in Gaston County, 1908.**" Project Director is Carol Reinhardt.
